

# HPE PPM Center 9.1 Deployment Management Training

## Overview

Take your skills beyond the PPM Essentials and Advanced courses by learning how to configure advanced deployment process logic and automation in your PPM implementation. Through discussions and hands-on exercises, you will learn to configure multi-server migration processes, designing and configuring automated workflows and object type logic. Students walk away from this course with a solid understanding of the procedures and tools for building and managing Deployment Management-driven processes.

You will receive expert instruction from a HPE PPM specialist who will present the course using slide presentation and facilitated discussion. At the end of each chapter there will be review questions followed by a hands on exercise to ensure understanding of each lesson.
